The event will take place at Richardson Farms, 6984 Lafayette Rd, beginning at 4:00pm, with hot dogs followed by the hayride then bonfire. Parking is near the pavilion where our group will be. The wagon will pick us up at the pavilion, go on the 45 minute hayride with the stop to pick pumpkins, and return us to the pavilion. The pavilion is covered and features picnic tables and gas grills. The bonfire will be right by the pavilion. This event will be fun regardless of the weather, because Richardson Farms will use a covered wagon in case of rain (open if dry), the food will be set up under cover, and the bonfire will be by the covered pavilion. You can leave whenever you want as the cars are parked right nearby (no need to wait for a wagon ride back). Richardson Farms is centrally located for the Wadsworth, Medina, and Brunswick nations, and is just 6.5 miles/10 min south of Medina Square on Rte 42.

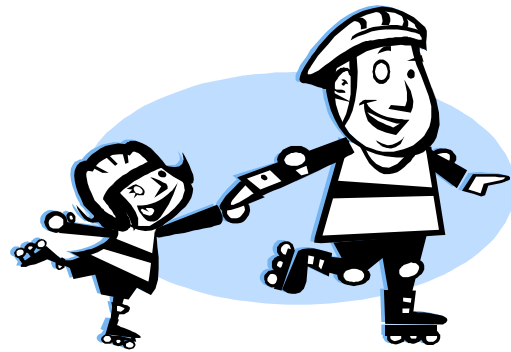

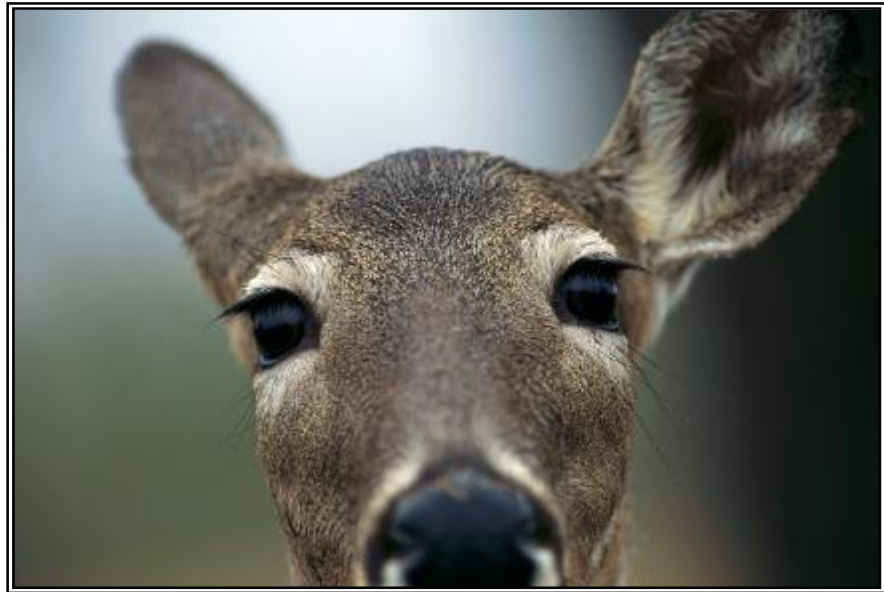
The Medina Guides Teens 1st themed campout of 2010 Present:
